04-441 <u>APPROVAL OF BUDGET – WASHOE COUNTY</u>

<u>1:30 p.m.</u> This was the time set in a Notice of Public Hearing published in the *Reno Gazette-Journal* on May 7, 2004 to consider the tentative and final budget for fiscal year 2004/05 for Washoe County. Proof was made that due and legal Notice had been given.

Chairman Shaw opened the public hearing by calling on anyone wishing to speak for or against the approval of the Washoe County budget. There being no response the Chairman closed the public hearing.

County Manager Katy Singlaub explained the Washoe County budget for 2004/05, as outlined in the agenda memorandum dated May 17, 2004.

John Sherman, Finance Director, noted that one position was added to the Coroner's operations. In response to Commissioner Galloway, Mr. Sherman confirmed that the additional rate necessary to fund indigent medical care is for the entire County and it is mandated by the State.

Chairman Shaw thanked Mr. Sherman and staff for the work on the budget. Commissioner Weber acknowledged the Charting Our Course Committee for their input and time involved with the budget process.

Chairman Shaw noted Commissioner Sferrazza's support of the Washoe County budget.

On motion by Commissioner Galloway, seconded by Commissioner Weber, which motion duly carried with Commissioners Humke and Sferrazza absent, Chairman Shaw ordered that the Washoe County budget for fiscal year 2004/05 be approved. It was further ordered that the classification changes be approved as submitted.
