SUBJECT:	Recommendation to reject all bids for the STMWRF Utility Operations Building Project. (Commission District 2.)

SUMMARY

Sealed bids for construction of the STMWRF Utility Operations Building project were opened on July 16, 2015. The list of bids received for the project is as follows:

Staff recommends that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) reject all bids for the proposed STMWRF Utility Operations Building since the lowest submitted bid exceeds the engineers estimate which is the maximum threshold established for this project. Staff will reissue the project for bidding with revised design and technical specifications which are expected to result in more favorable bid costs without materially impacting the quality of the design.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Safe, secure and healthy communities.

PREVIOUS ACTION

There has been no previous action taken regarding this bid.



BACKGROUND

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The STMWRF Utility Operations Building Project involves the construction of a new 4,800 square foot metal framed building shell with a 2,200 square foot office space, including full restroom facilities and showers. The structure will also be utilized for storage of sensitive equipment and parts. The STMWRF Utility Operations Building will house seven full time utility operations staff and in addition provide working space for three engineers primarily stationed at the 9th Street Office while conducting work at the STMWRF facility.

The need for this facility is the outcome of the December 31, 2014 consolidation of the Washoe County water utility with the Truckee Meadows Water Authority and the subsequent termination of the lease of office and warehouse space at 4930 Energy Way, Reno.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no direct fiscal impact for this item.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners reject all bids for the STMWRF Utility Operations Building project.

POSSIBLE MOTION

Should the Board agree with staff's recommendation, a possible motion would be "Move to reject all bids for the STMWRF Utility Operations Building project."
