SUBJECT: Recommendation to approve a grant award [not to exceed \$17,200, no match required] from the US Marshal's Office for reimbursement of overtime costs incurred while participating in the US Marshal's Regional Fugitive Investigative Strike Teams (FIST) during the retroactive FFY period of 10/3/15-9/30/16; and if approved, authorize Comptroller's Office to make necessary budget adjustments. (All Commission Districts)

SUMMARY

These funds from the United States Marshals Service will be used to reimburse the County for overtime expenses incurred for the investigation and arrest of fugitives by deputies working on the Regional Fugitive Investigative Strike Teams (FIST). Email authorization for the immediate use of these funds was received from the US Marshal's Office on November 4, 2015, and this award was submitted to the first available BCC meeting immediately upon receipt of that notification.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Safe, Secure and healthy communities.

PREVIOUS ACTION

None.

BACKGROUND

In the 1980's the U.S. Marshals Service inaugurated the use of Fugitive Investigative Strike Teams, referred as FIST operations, to capture violent fugitives that were wanted by Federal and local law enforcement agencies. The goal of a FIST operation was to locate and arrest a large number of fugitives in a particular region, within a relatively brief period, by focusing the resources of local, state, and Federal law enforcement agencies.

That concept has been extended to the state level. The Washoe County Sheriff's Office and the United States Marshals Service, pursuant to the Presidential Threat Protection

Act of 2000, have established the Nevada Fugitive Investigative Strike Team Task Force (NV-FIST) for the purpose of locating and apprehending fugitives. The funds provided by the U.S. Marshals Service help to defray costs associated with investigation and arrest of fugitives from justice.
