SUMMARY

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office has received a donation in the form of a single 1980 tanker trailer with an estimated value of \$4000.00. The tanker trailer will be utilized as a training instrument for the partnering agencies of the Regional Public Safety Training Center (RPSTC.)

BACKGROUND

Captain Eric Millette from the Sparks Fire Department contacted Sierra Chemical on behalf of the RPSTC. Captain Millette was aware of the partnering fire agencies' desire to train on a tanker trailer and was able to procure the trailer through Sierra Chemical.

This procurement is of no cost to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office or the partnering agencies of the RSPTC.
