SUMMARY

The Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office (DRMO) offered the donation of various military surplus equipment to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office to be utilized to support several specialized tactical teams. This equipment was obtained at no charge to the county from the military.

The Board of County Commissioners has accepted DRMO donations for the Sheriff's Office yearly with the last acceptance being June 16, 2015.
