SUMMARY

Michael Kattelman seeks reappointment to the Law Library Board of Trustees and Pamela Gullihur seeks reappointment to the Law Library Board of Trustees. It is recommended that Michael Kattelman serve as an attorney member for a two-year term expiring on January 31, 2019, and Pamela Gullihur serve as a non-attorney member for a two-year term expiring January 31, 2019.

County and District Court Strategic Objective supported by this item: Encourage Citizen Participation.

PREVIOUS ACTION

In January 28, 2014, the BCC appointed Clayton Brust and Lynne Simons to a second term as attorney members of the Law Library Board of Trustees and Teresa Mentzer to a third term as a non-attorney member of the Law Library Board of Trustees. In January 27, 2015, the BCC appointed Michael Kattelman to a first term as an attorney member of the Law Library Board of Trustees and Pamela Gullihur to serve a fifth term as a non-attorney member of the Law Library Board of Trustees. In January 12, 2016, the BCC appointed Clayton Brust to a third term as an attorney member of the Law Library Board of Trustees and Teresa Mentzer to a fourth term as a non-attorney member of the Law

Library Board of Trustees. The Law Library Board of Trustees appointed members serve a two year term and meet quarterly.

BACKGROUND

The Law Library is made up of two attorneys and two non-attorneys appointed by the Board of County Commissioners for two-year terms that overlap. The Board also has three district judge members designated by the District Court Judges. The Board of Trustees meets on a quarterly basis.
