- WHEREAS,** Disney and ABC, working with Youth Service America (YSA), awards \$500 Disney of Summer Service grants for youth-led service projects; and
- WHEREAS,** Eight-year-old Adylenn Trimble, a second grader at Spanish Springs Elementary School, applied for the grant, submitting a video, drawing and on-line application; and
- WHEREAS,** Adylenn won the \$500 grant for her project proposal K.I.N.D. (Kids in Need Donations from Kids) to do a book and warm clothing drive for Kids Kottage and tied it into the Spanish Springs Elementary School's annual Fleecing for Friends project; and
- WHEREAS,** A total of 340 youths were awarded grants in the United States, four were in Nevada and Adylenn was the only youth to receive the grant in northern Nevada; and
- WHEREAS,** Adylenn received so many donations, 3,274 books and 915 items of clothing, that she was able to spread the donations to several other organizations and some books even went as far away as Africa; and
- WHEREAS,** Adylenn designed flyers, counted, sorted and tracked all the donations, shopped for additional items purchased with the grant money and helped deliver most of the donations and is already thinking of new projects to help those in need;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Washoe County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim our heartfelt gratitude and thanks Adylenn Trimble and the students and faculty of Spanish Springs Elementary School for their extraordinary community service.
