SUMMARY

The Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office (DRMO) offered the donation of various military surplus equipment to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office to be utilized to support several specialized tactical teams. This equipment was obtained at no charge to the county from the military.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Safe, secure and healthy communities.

PREVIOUS ACTION

The Board of County Commissioners has accepted DRMO donations for the Sheriff's Office yearly with the last acceptances being May 17, 2016, June 16, 2015, and June 24, 2014. On November 15, 2016 BCC also accepted a DRMO helicopter UH-1H Huey.
