Perfect Time to be a New CEO

RNO was on a great trajectory, then COVID hit

- 6,000 passengers March 6 -- drops to 212 on April 15, 2020
- Slashed budget, froze positions, implemented furloughs
- Imposed mask requirements a month before the Directive
- Pivoted from advertising flights, to promoting safety
- Aggressive sanitization 24/7
- Custodians are heroes








Operating Expenses


- \$44.392 Budget for FY2020-2021
- \$29.597M expensed thru March 2021 or 12% below budget
- As many as 21 vacant or frozen positions during the year





Operating Revenues


- \$37.594M Budget for FY2020-21
- \$31.616M received thru March 2021 or 15% ahead of budget forecast
- 16% decline from March 2019
- Does not include CARES/CRRSA


This Summer - RNO is Taking Off

May 2021 Schedule














Airport Improvements/Investments


